1. According to Isaiah 66.2, who does God look to?
2. Isaiah tells us that one who *trembles at the Word* is precious in the eyes of God. What is the Word of God? Discuss the following text: 2 Peter 1.19-21 and 2 Timothy 3.16-17.
3. According to Isaiah what should our approach to the Word of God be (66.2)? What does it mean to *tremble at the Word*?
4. Besides the approach mentioned here what are some other ways in which we approach the Word of God?
5. Take some time to look at Psalm 19.7-11 and see why we would should tremble at the Word of God. What do we learn about the Word of God and its work in our life?

 - c. Psalm 19.8a (Psalm 119.16, 24, 47)
 - d. Psalm 19.8b (Ephesians 1.18; Psalm 119.18)
 - e. Psalm 19.10 (Psalm 119.72, 103)
 - f. Psalm 19.11 (Psalm 119.9, 11)
