Colossians: The Supremacy of Christ

Read Deuteronomy 6.1-9

1. What does Deuteronomy mean? Answer: *deuteron = repeat; nomos = law*; a restating of the law.
2. What was the background to God's words through Moses that were spoke to the Israelites?
3. What are the three phrases that were mentioned from the sermon? What do they mean?
4. What was the first and main truth that God wanted the Israelites to hang on to (Deuteronomy 6.4)? Do you have rivals to God (idols) in your life? If so, decide how you are going to crush them? There may be things that you need to get out of your house or off your TV or even things off your schedule. If so, confess and repent.
5. What is the great duty that we are called to (Deuteronomy 6.5)? How would you define biblical love? Is this displayed in your life and your home?
6. Who is getting your heart (Deuteronomy 6.6)?
7. How would you define *worldview*? What about *biblical worldview*?
8. How are you shaping your children or grandchildren to have a *biblical worldview*?
9. What is your primary goal for your children? What is your part in their spiritual life and growth? What should it be (Deuteronomy 6.4-9; Proverbs 22.6)?
10. Do you have a plan to train your children?
