2. What does the cross look like to God (1 John 2.1-2; John 3.16)? What does propitiation mean?
3. What is Christ's perspective of the cross (John 8.29; Mark 10.45, 14.36; 1 Peter 3.18)?
4. What does it mean when Paul says speaking of Christ, *although He existed in the form of God, did not regard equality with God a thing to be grasped (2.6)*?
5. How does Satan view the cross (Revelation 12)?
6. What is sin's perspective of the cross?
7. What is your perspective of the cross?
8. What do you say to someone that might say the following: *Look, I'm pleased if you think this Jesus helps you. If he makes you feel better and enables you to cope and find some sort of significance in life, I'm happy for you. But frankly, I don't need your religion. I like you as a friend, but if this friendship is going anywhere, you and this Jesus will have to stay off my back.*
